Achievements – What are the lasting works of this society?

- What things were built to last?
- Which ideas, if any, still affect people today?

Political System – Who runs the society and how do they run it?

- Who has power and how was it used?
- How do those with power keep it or lose it?

Economics – How does a society use its scarce resource?

- What are the most valuable resources in a society?
- How are the resources distributed?

Social Structure – What are the different levels of classes in a society?

- Who are the “most important” people in society? Why are they considered important?
- Who is at the bottom of society? Why?

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
