TREATY POINTS

IN YOUR OWN WORDS

<p>1. Britain recognizes the United States (the thirteen states) to be free, sovereign, and independent states, and that the British Crown will surrender rights to the Government, property, and territorial rights of the United States; Vocabulary Sovereign-a nation's power to completely rule itself Surrender-give up</p>	
<p>2. Establishing the boundaries of the United States between the United States and British North America;</p>	
<p>3. Granting fishing rights to United States fishermen in the Grand Banks, off the coast of Newfoundland and in the Gulf of Saint Lawrence;</p>	
<p>4. Recognizing the lawful debt owed to be paid back on either side; Vocabulary Debt-Money you owe to someone</p>	
<p>5. The Congress of the United States will "earnestly recommend" to state governments to recognize the rightful owners of all confiscated lands and "provide for the repayment of all things which have been confiscated belonging to British subjects" (Loyalists); Vocabulary Earnestly-Seriously Confiscated-Take away (usually for punishment)</p>	
<p>6. United States will prevent future confiscations of the property of Loyalists; Vocabulary Confiscated-Take away (usually for punishment)</p>	
<p>7. Prisoners of war on both sides are to be released; all property of the British army (including slaves) now in the United States is to remain and be forfeited; Vocabulary Forfeited-give up</p>	
<p>8. Great Britain and the United States are each to be given perpetual access to the Mississippi River; Vocabulary Perpetual-Neverending</p>
